## BACKGROUND

Odisha Voluntary Health Association (OVHA) is a state level federation of Voluntary organizations those are engaged in the field of Health and Development in the State of Odisha. It is a non- profit making society having a secular constitution, established in the year 1974 and registered under Society Registration Act 1860 in the year 1976.

The genesis of OVHA can be related to be national level voluntary health association movement started in late sixties. The Bangalore Meet of Leaders of voluntary Hospitals and Health Associations held in July 1969 called for coordination and collaboration for promoting community health. Accordingly as a result, an association known as "Coordinating Agency for Health Planning" (CAHP) was formed. Dr. James S. Tong, the then director of catholic hospital association of India and Dr. James MC Gilvrary the then director of CMC, World council of churches Geneva, were the two inspiring forces in this movement. Later on in a National Convention in the city of Madras in September 1974, a National Federation called "Voluntary Health Association of India" (VHAI) was formed replacing the CAHP. Meanwhile Voluntary Health Associations were established at State level too, Bihar Voluntary Association being the first of its kind in 1969 followed by OVHA IN 1974.



## I. INTRODUCTION

Orissa Voluntary Health Association (OVHA) has completed 45 years of service by 2019. It is a matter of great pleasure and honor for OVHA and its member Organisation for their commitment and contribution in the field of health and allied fields. Member organisations are proud to be a part of the Oldest & Largest network of voluntary organisations working in the field of health in Odisha. We all are working together to improve the health indicators of our state. The task is gigantic. But we all as a committed group will carry forward our mission to see a better & just society where all have access to health facilities in and around their habitat.

OVHA as an association is committed to make health a reality. To achieve this goal the association has not left any stone unturned. Starting from awareness generation, capacity building of service providers and distribution of IEC materials at all levels by direct intervention or facilitate the member organisation to carry out the activities. A special attention is given on spatial distribution of work. The association ensures quality intervention. In some cases the association also carries out the pilot projects to show it as models.

- v. To collect, exchange and disseminate health information as well as to do research;
- vi. To conduct training programmes, seminars, workshops, conferences etc. related to health and development work;
- vii. To promote rational drug therapy;
- viii. To promote alternative system of health care;
- ix. To promote working with committed, dedicated and interested people of good will of all religions and communities ;
- x. To promote educational understanding in communities to improve the quality of their lives by development of local human and material resources;
- xi. To promote school health programme ;
- xii. To present voluntary health services in different states, national and international level;
- xiii. To promote collective action for community health and development;
- xiv. To undertake any other act, which will promote health status of the state .

#### STRUCTURE OF OVHA

OVHA has two types of members- organisation


members and associate members. Together they form the General Body - the highest decision making body of the organisation. The General Body members are eligible to cast their vote as secret ballot to elect 11 Governing Body members. The Executive Director is an Ex-Officio member of the GB. The Governing Body elects the office bearers and looks after the activities of OVHA, which is executed by the Executive Director. Executive Director is one of the key pin of the organisation and establish link between management and staff.

#### MEMBERSHIP

OVHA has two types of members like organisation members and associate members. A structured application form has been developed in due consultation with its members for membership of OVHA. After proper scrutiny of the documents and field appraisal, the Governing Body recommends the name of the applicant organisations to General Body for induction in to OVHA as a member. In case of Associate members, individuals of reputation and expertise in the field of health and development are inducted as associate member of OVHA. The Annual membership fee is Rs.200/- for both categories. However, organisation members those who have completed three successful years of membership can also become Life Member by paying Rs.5,000/- only.

## II. PRIMARY HEALTH CARE

Public private partnership (PPP) has emerged as one of the important strategies for health sector reform in Odisha. Initiatives have been taken by National Rural Health Mission, Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Odisha to undertake different PPPs in meeting the growing needs for health services and other national health programmes. With the support of the State Government, OVHA is managing 3 numbers of PHC (N). One is in Kalahandi district at Adri in Thuamul Rampur block and the rest are in Kandhamal district – PHC (N) Judabali in Kotagarh block and PHC (N) Mardipanka in Daringbadi Block.

Achievements:

### PHC (N) ADRI, KALAHANDI

Public private partnership (PPP) has emerged as

one of the important strategies for health sector reform in ODISHA. Initiatives have taken by National Health Mission , Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Odisha to under take different PPPs in meeting the growing needs for health services and other National health programmes . with the support of the State Government ,OVHA is managing the Adri PHC(N) under Public Private Partnership .

Achievements:

The OPD is functioning 24x7 hours with alternative support of the Allopathic doctor., Ayurvedic doctor and other paramedics . Every day more than 40 patients from nearby villages are visiting to this health unit for treatment.

We also refer serious patients to CHC Thuamul Rampur and DHH, Bhawanipatna.


